



Insect Bites and/or Stings

Minor bites and stings can be treated by:-

- Washing the affected area
- Placed a cold compress over the affected area to reduce swelling
- Not scratching as it can become infected

Additional Treatment if the bite is painful or swollen you can also take paracetamol or ibuprofen (not for children under 16 yrs.).

You can take an antihistamine tablet to help reduce swelling (antihistamines are available from pharmacies).

Only see your GP if the redness & itching gets worse or does not clear up after a few days.



Atishoo!! It's Hay Fever Season

There are more than 10 million people with hay fever in England. It can have a significant negative impact on quality of life. People with severe (allergic rhinitis) often find it disrupts their productivity at school or work. Hay Fever can lead to complications such as sinusitis, which may last several months and require GP appointments, antibiotics & other medications. Most cases of Hay Fever can be treated using over-the-counter (OTC) medication. If you start to get sniffles, itches & sneezes, visit www.nhs.uk/Conditions/hay-fever for information & speak to your Pharmacist about remedies.

Repeat Prescriptions – Telephone requests for repeat prescriptions should only be made by HOUSEBOUND PATIENTS and these calls should be made after 2pm. This helps keep the phone lines clear for patients to make an appointment.



Travel Vaccinations

If you require any vaccinations/advice relating to foreign travel, you will need to complete a travel questionnaire at least 6-8 weeks prior to travel. Required information should include which countries and areas within each country you are visiting. The surgery will then contact you to book an appointment, if necessary, with one of our nurses. You can collect a form from either reception or you can submit a form online on our practice website: www.pennyshillpractice.co.uk under 'Travel Vaccinations'. If you are traveling in less than 6-8 weeks you may be asked to go to a travel clinic to have your vaccinations.

From April 2016 patients may request Online Access to Book Appointments, order Repeat Prescriptions, and now view Medical Records, you can do this either via the website www.pennyshillpractice.co.uk or complete a form from reception.

Blood Tests

We are delighted to offer a limited number of blood tests at the surgery.

Unfortunately this is not yet enough to fully meet the demand and so you may often find it is quicker to use one of the local hospitals, see below for details (for example, the open access at Christchurch often does not have a wait early afternoon).

Sometimes your test can only be taken at the hospital and you will be advised of this if appropriate.

While you are welcome to have your blood tests here, we hope you will continue to use the hospital if possible, to allow our more elderly and less mobile patients and those without transport to have priority in the surgery.

We hope in the future to be able to expand this service to improve access to all our patients and will keep you informed about developments.
